Items and documents to submit and upload

ALL applicants are required to submit and upload supporting documents.

All supporting documents that are not in English **must** be accompanied by an official certified English translation of the contents.

Documents submitted in a language other than English **will not be accepted**.

The maximum file size of each file should not exceed 1MB. If they exceed 1 MB, Google "Compress PDF file for free" to reduce your documents to 1MB.

You are not required to submit the documents in hardcopy.

Before you upload your documents, please name your documents according to "**Field name_Your name_Your Home University**". For example, "Transcript_John Smith_NUS".

Items and documents to submit and upload		
Item	Field	Remarks
1.	Transcript	Your latest academic transcript with grade legend in PDF format.
2.	Record of courses taken in current semester/term	Courses that you are currently taking, but not reflected in the academic transcript.
3.	NRIC/ FIN/ Passport	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> International Students should upload a copy of your passport bio-data page. Singapore Citizens or Singapore Permanent Residents should upload a copy of the front and back of your NRIC. If you are already holding on to a valid pass which allows you to stay in Singapore, upload a copy of the front and back of the pass.
4.	Student Status Letter from Home University	A letter issued by your home university, indicating your expected month & year of graduation and current student status .
5.	Curriculum Vitae (CV)	A one-page A4 CV. PDF format. File size should not exceed 1MB.
6.	Business Proposal	A one-page A4 Business Proposal to articulate an idea you are working on / plan to pursue, including the stage your idea is at. PDF format. File size should not exceed 1MB.

7.	Introduction Video	<p>Prepare a link to an introduction video of no more than 2 minutes. The video to briefly include the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Introduction about yourself• Reason you are interested in joining the NUS Enterprise Summer Programme in Entrepreneurship. (30 seconds)• Pitch a business proposal which highlights a problem you wish to solve and explain how you plan to address it. If you have a startup, pitch the problem and solution. (1 min)• Any other information that you would like to share with us (awards, relevant experience, intention to further studies, etc.) (30 seconds) <p>[Note: Please ensure that your video URL is set to public visibility]</p>						
8.	TOEFL / IELTS test scores (For applicants who are from non-English medium universities)	<p>If English is not your home university’s primary language, you are required to upload your English proficiency document during your application. We shall deem that students nominated are suitable to come on exchange and would be able to cope with the rigorous curriculum conducted in English at NUS.</p> <table><tr><th>Test</th><th>Minimum Acceptable Score</th></tr><tr><td>IELTS</td><td>6.5</td></tr><tr><td>TOEFL</td><td>85 for the Internet-based test</td></tr></table> <p>Please note that only TOEFL and / or IELTS scores obtained in the two years leading up to 15 March of the year of application will be considered.</p> <p>For instance, for applications closing on 15 March 2026, the validity period for the scores is from 15 March 2024 to 15 March 2026 (both dates inclusive).</p>	Test	Minimum Acceptable Score	IELTS	6.5	TOEFL	85 for the Internet-based test
